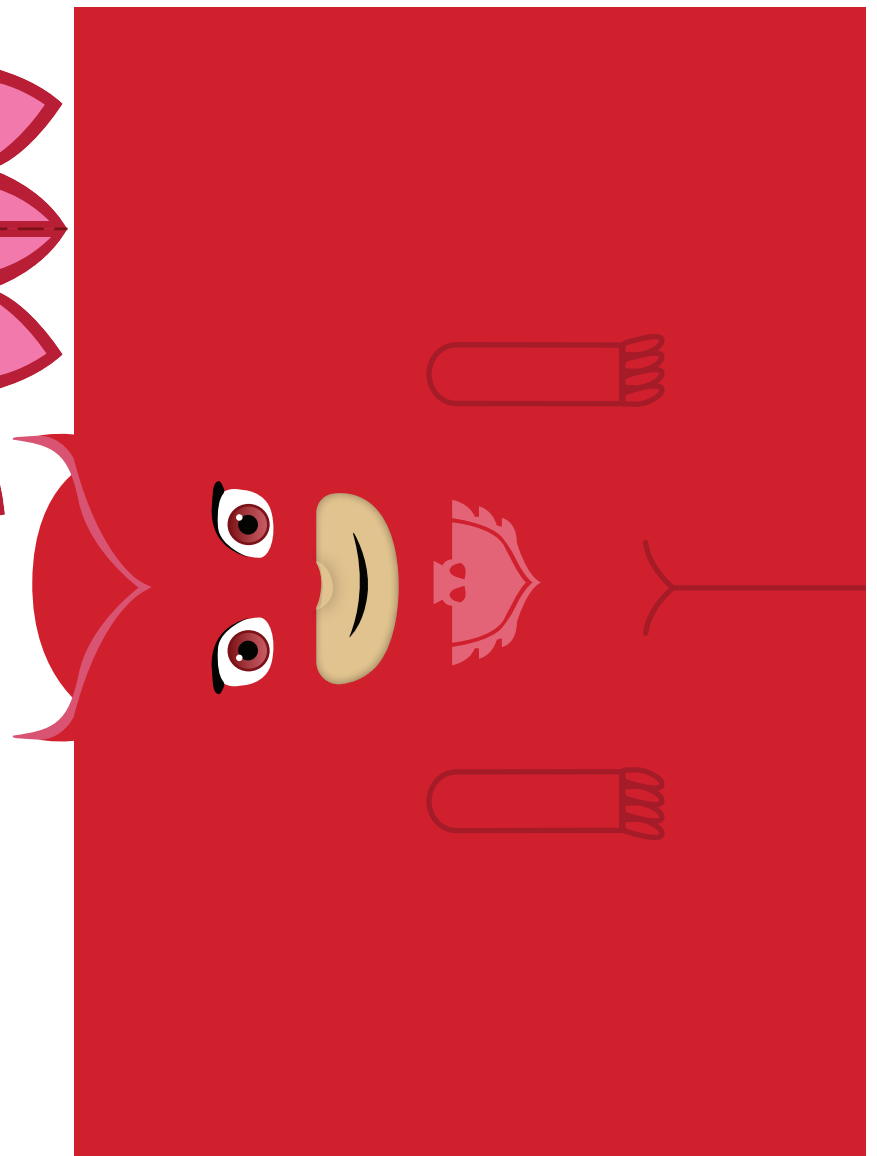
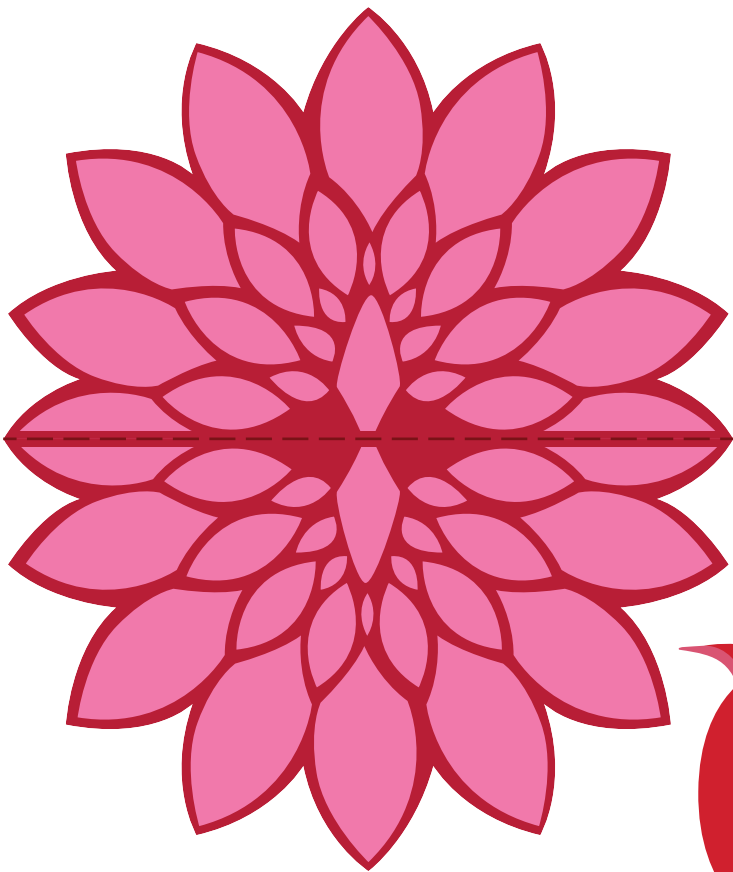
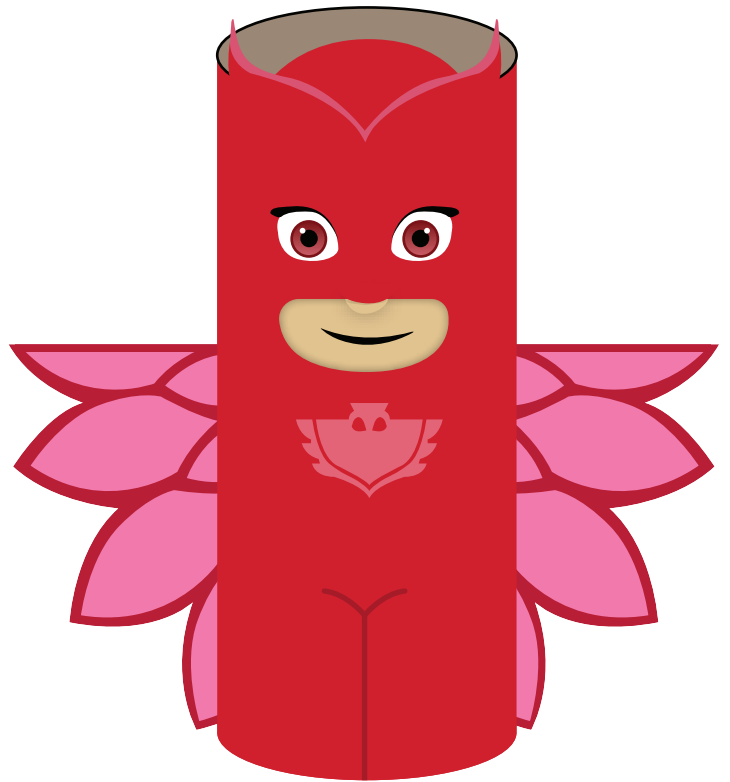


Owlette

3. Fold cape along dotted line and attach to back

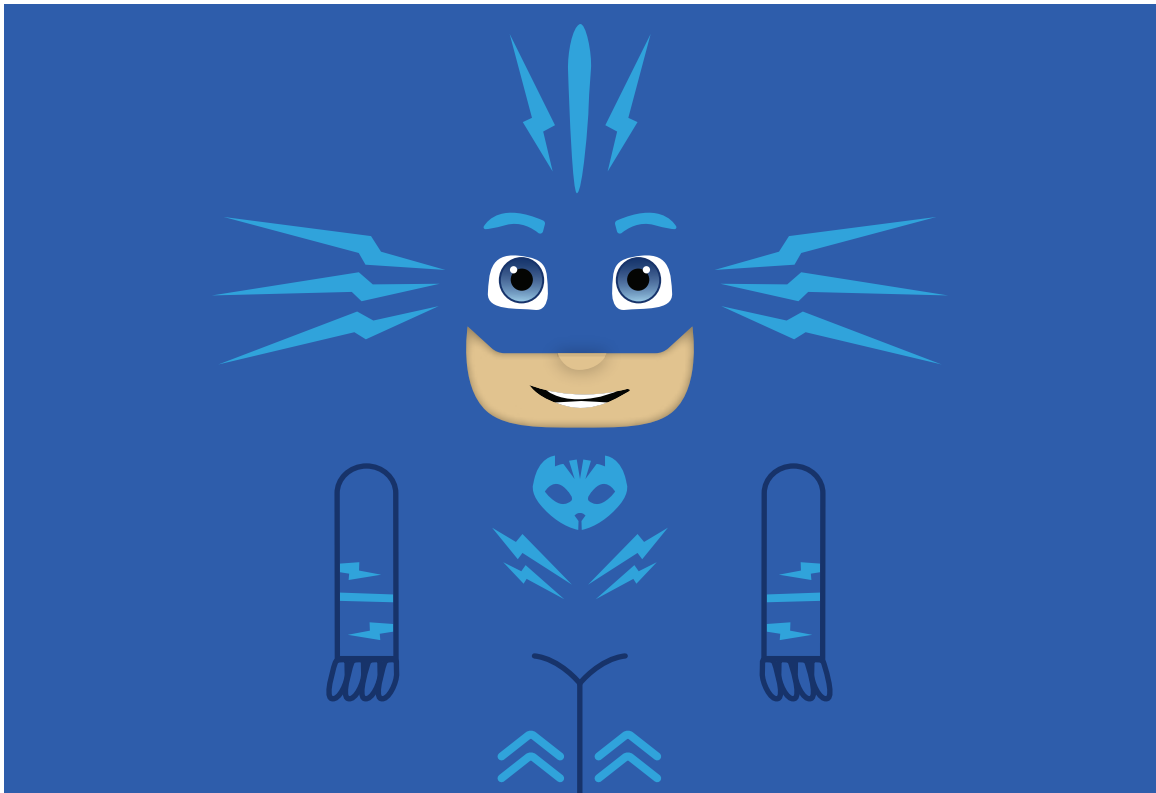
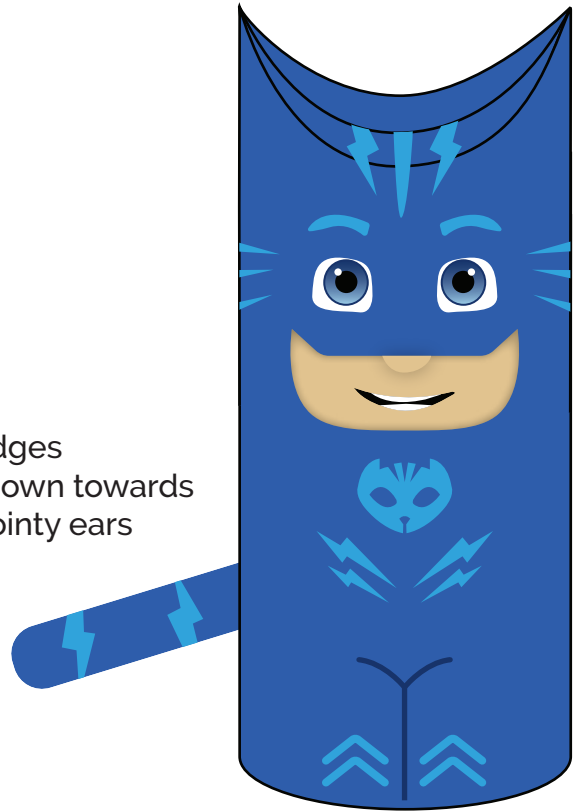


Catboy

4. Attach tail to back using tab

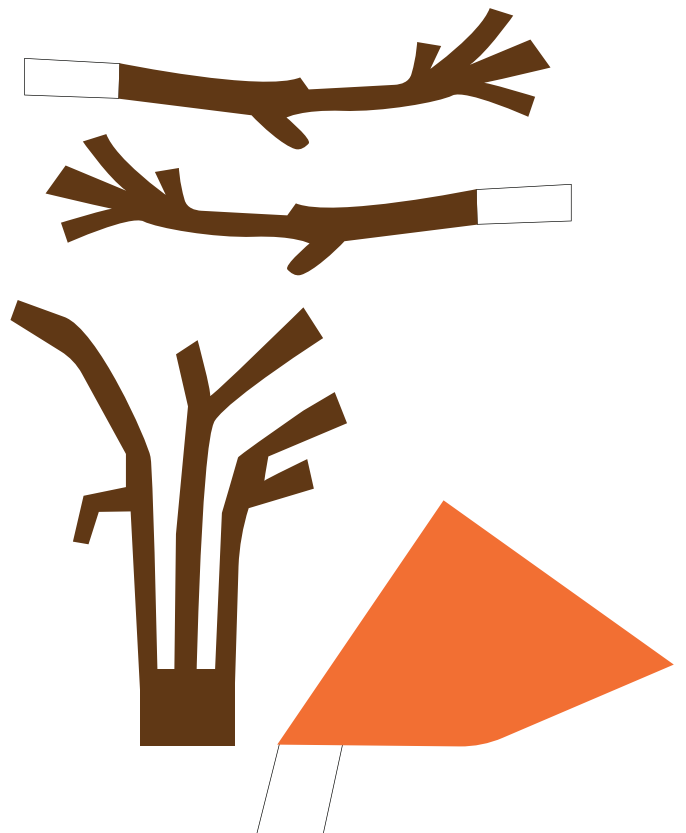
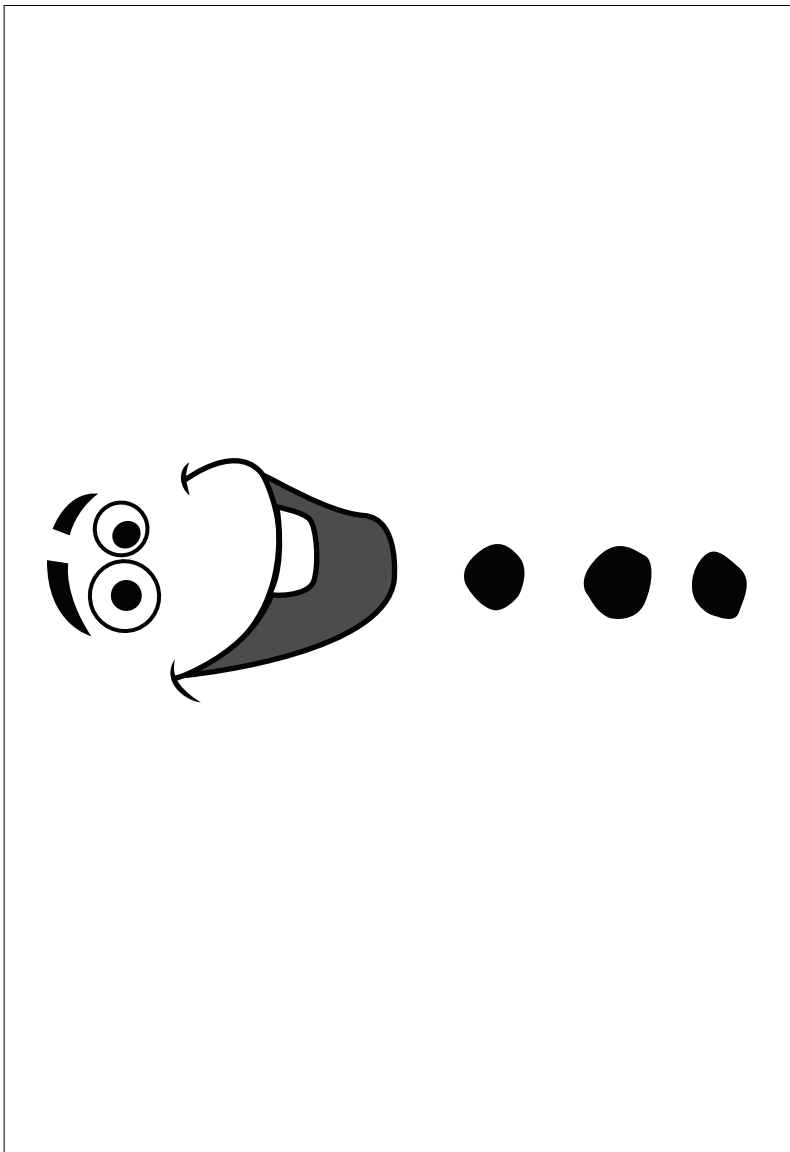


Olaf

5. Roll nose into a cone, secure with tape, then attach to face with tab behind cone

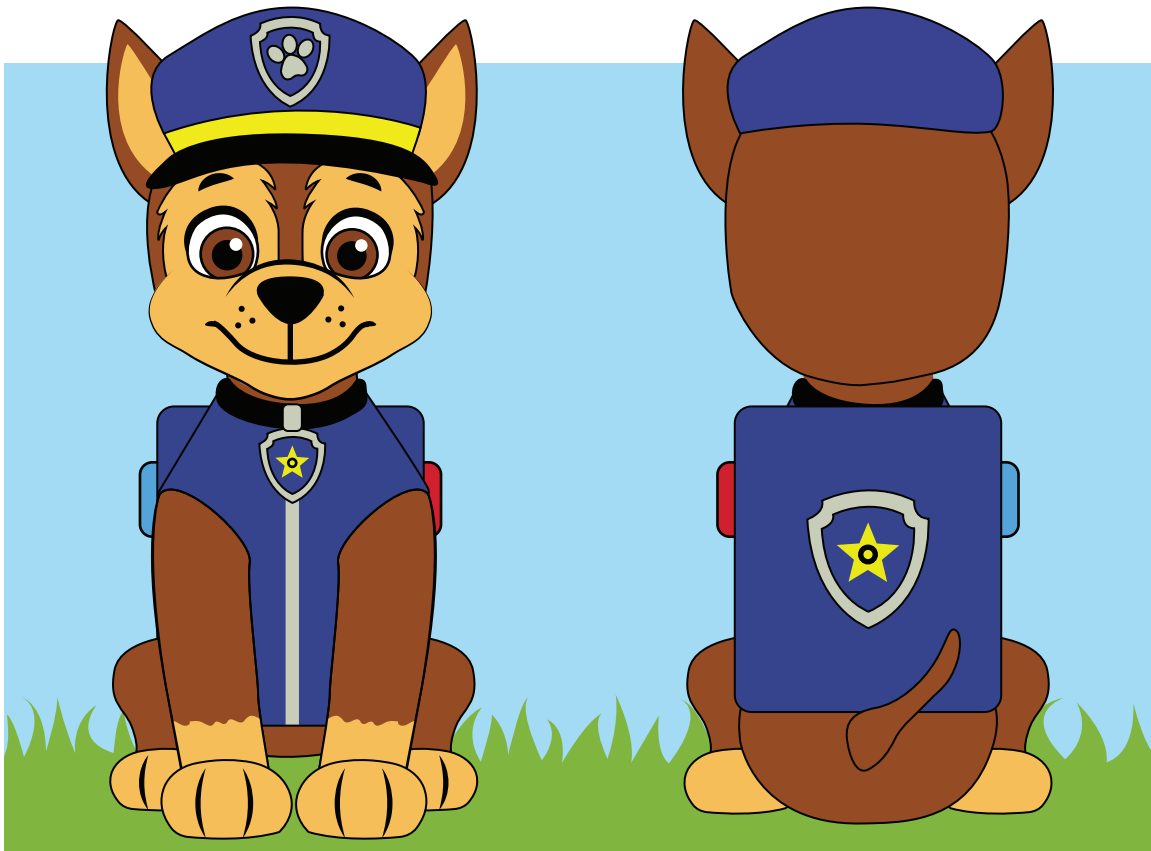
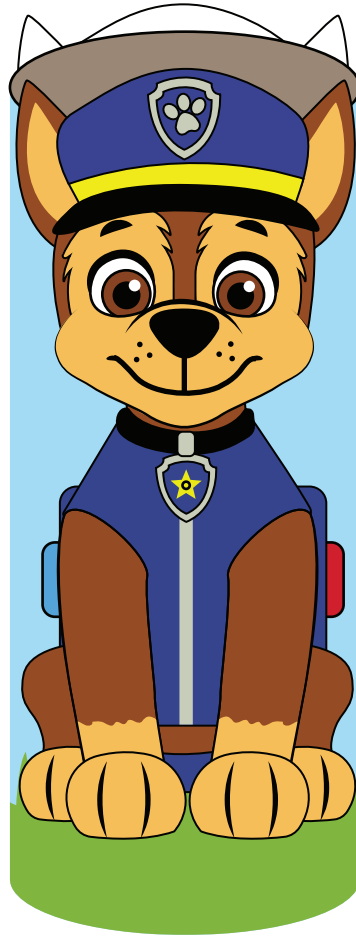


Chase

2. Wrap body print around tube

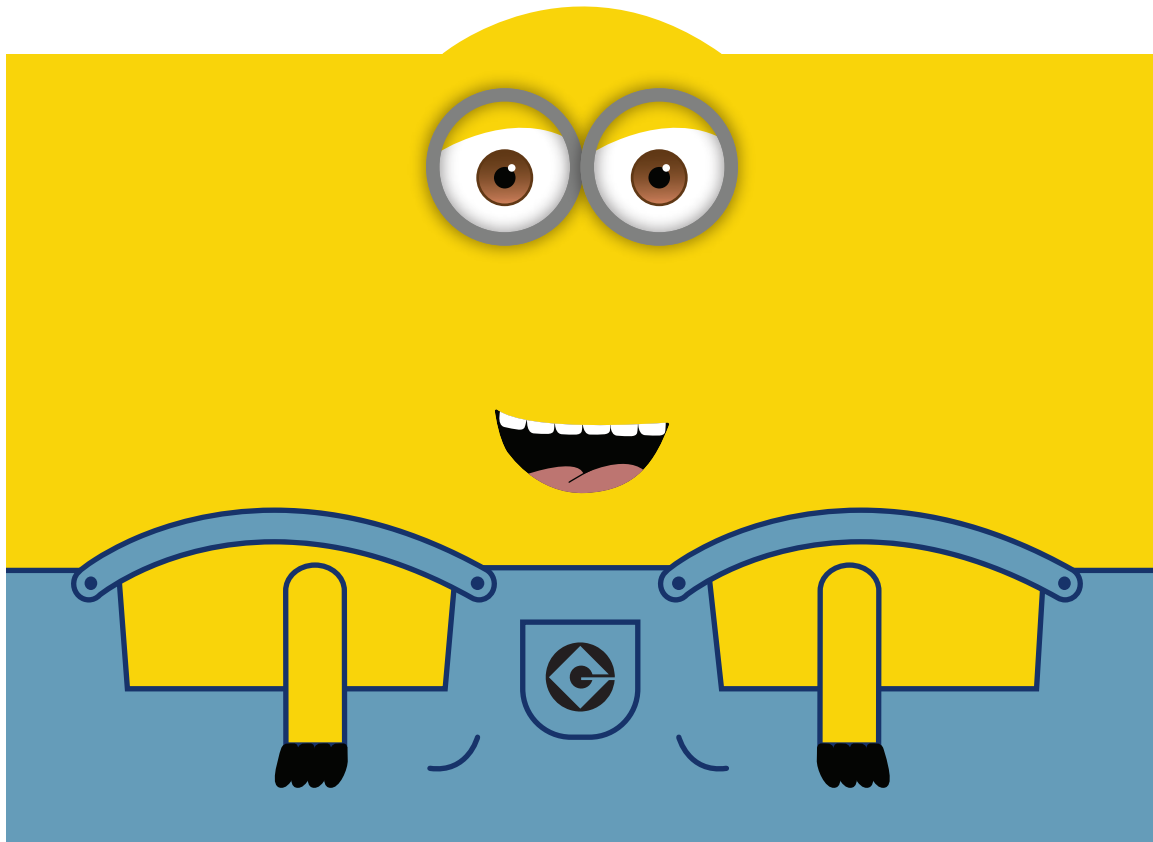
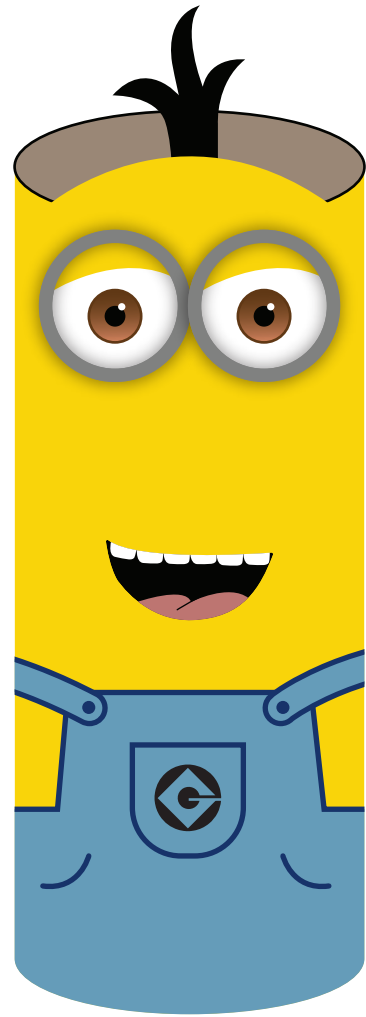


Minion

3. Attach hair to inside of tube

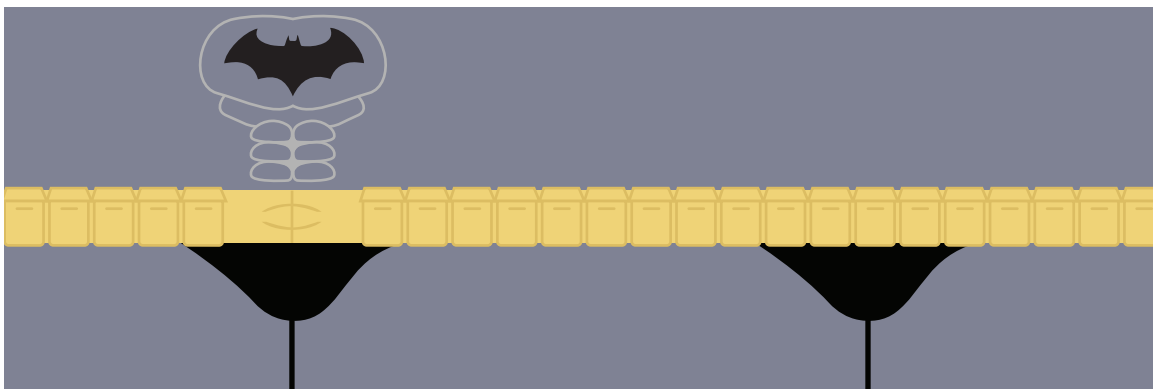
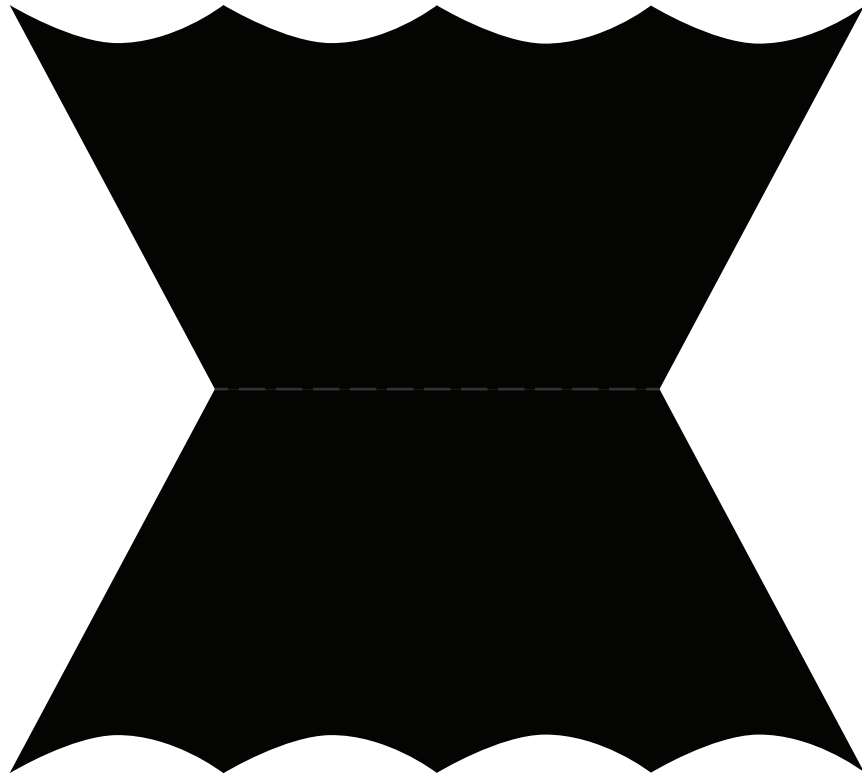
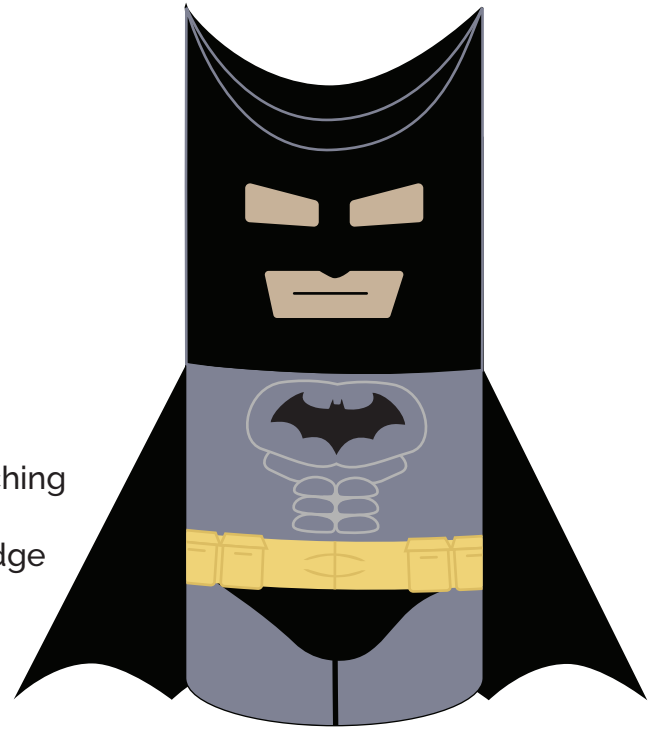


Batman

5. With a black marker, draw on Batman's mask and face

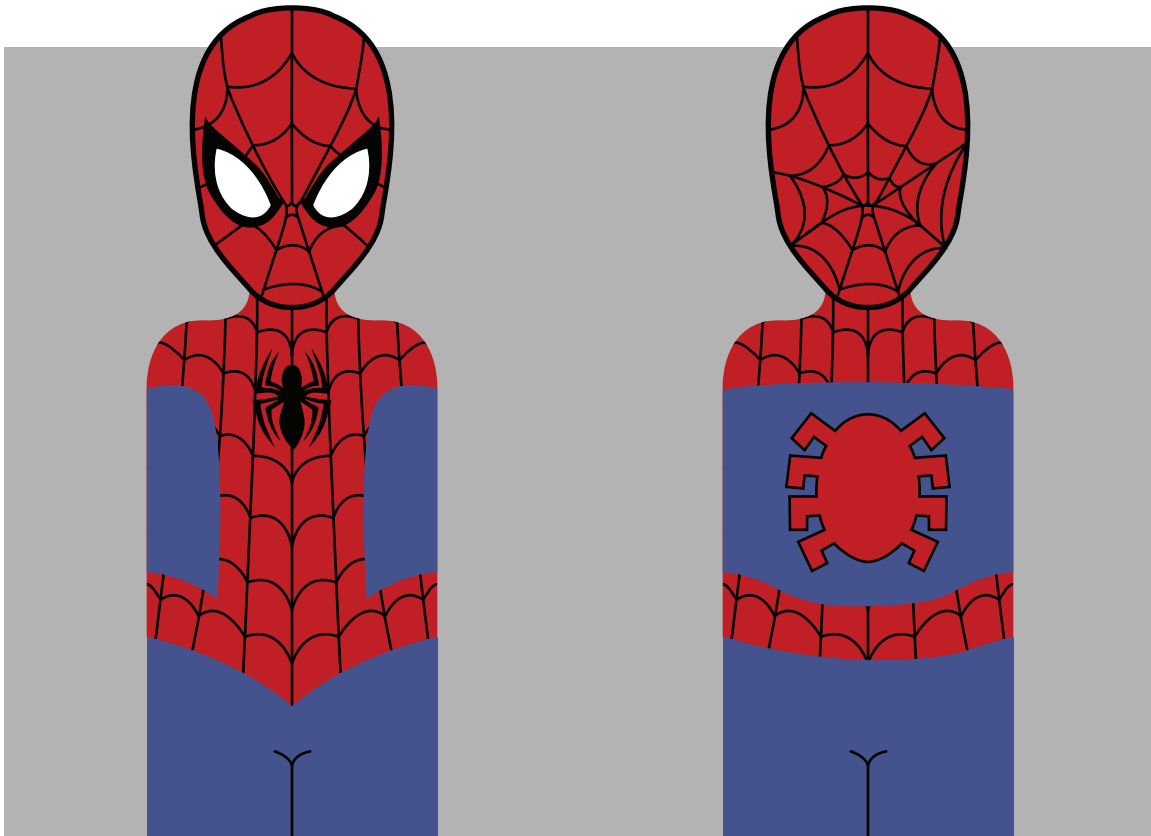
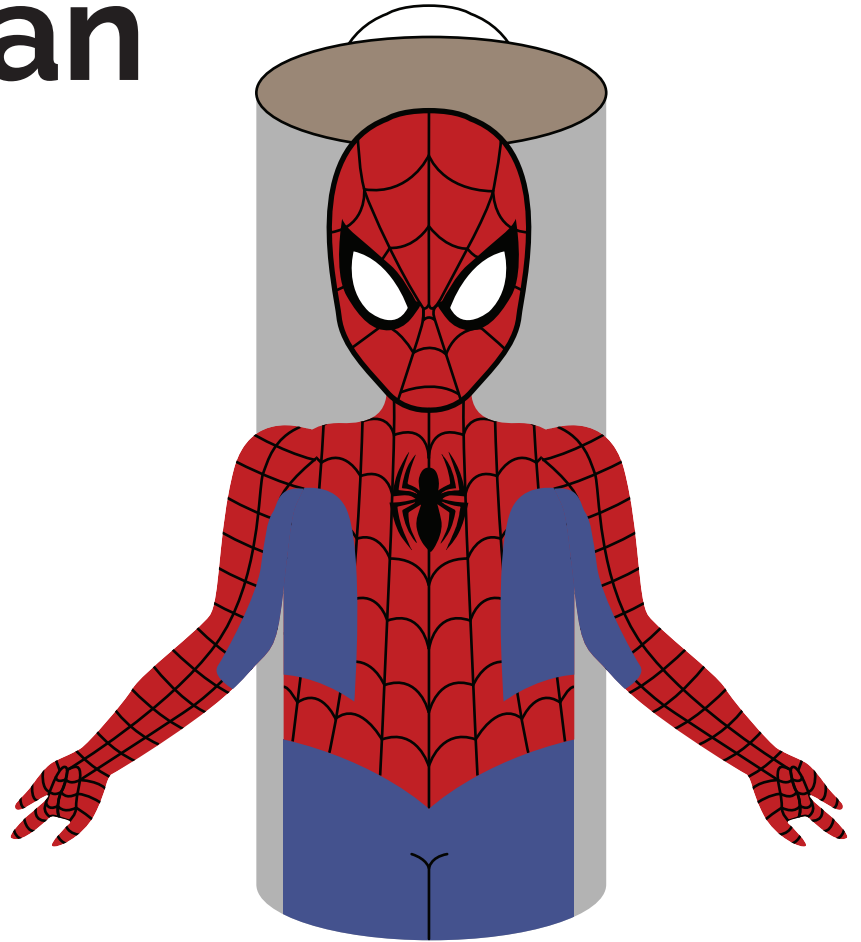
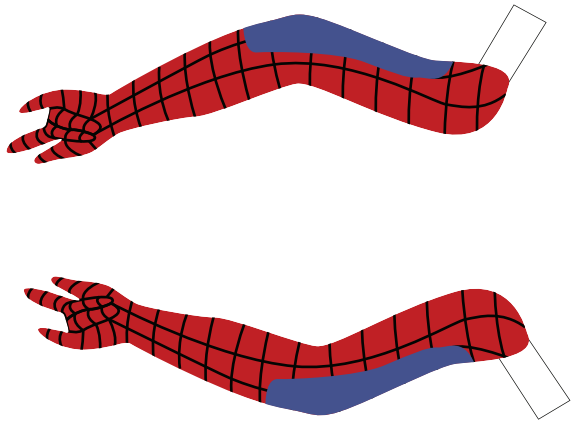


Spider-Man
